# Homo Habilis "The Handyman"

## Appearance:

- Long flat head
- Small brain
- 1.5 m tall
- Walked with a stoop

### Shelter:


- Made out of branches
- Lived in only warm places
- Did not know how to make clothes
- Did not know how to make fire
- Skeleton fossils have been found in Africa

### Food:

- Plants
- Bird's eggs
- Wild animals (like pigs)
- Would kill animals with rocks
- Would scrape off the hide and eat meat raw

#### Tools:

- All tools are made of stone
- Use a hammer to kill animals (rock)
- Sharp rock edge (knife) to cut open animals
- Scraper used to shave off meat

# Homo Erectus "Upright Man"

## Appearance:

- Large bony eyebrow ridges
- No chin
- 1.5 m tall
- Spoke very little (grunts and noises)

### Shelter:

- Lived in caves
- Fossils found in Africa, Europe, Asia, Germany, and England

#### Food:

- Better hunting tools = more food
- Attacked large animals
- Wild plants


## Tools:

- More advanced tools than Homo Habilis
- Used bones/rocks to chip away at materials to make blades for cutting
- Blades were put on wooden sticks and made spears
- Spears helped to improve hunting techniques

### Fire:

- Knew how to make fire (rubbing two sticks together)
- Could live in colder climates
- Could cook food
- Used fire to protect themselves
- Light at night

## **Neanderthal**

## Appearance:

- Large bony eyebrow ridges
- Small chin
- Taller than Homo Erectus
- Large bottom lip
- Wore some clothes made from animal hide

#### Shelter:

- Lived in caves
- Buried their dead
- Graves found in floors of caves
- Wrapped dead and placed flowers at graves
- Fossils found in Africa, Europe, Asia, Germany, and England

#### Food:

- Better hunting tools = more food options
- Attacked large animals
- Used fire to smoke bears out of caves
- Wild plants
- Cooked meat


#### Tools:

- More advanced
- Many different tools
- Used chipped rocks to make knives, spears, blade sharpeners
- Tools helped to hunt different animals, build shelters, and protect themselves against wild animals

#### Fire:

- Knew how to make fire
- Lived in colder places
- Cooked their food
- Used fire to protect themselves
- Had light at night

## **Cro-Magnon**

### Appearance:

- High foreheads
- Large chins
- Large brains (smarter than previous early humans)
- Taller than average humans
- Could speak
- Wore some clothes made from animal hide

#### Tools:

- More advanced than Neanderthals
- Many tools
- Used flint to make sharp blades
- Made chisels, knives, spear-points, needles, fish hooks, and harpoon heads
- Tools helped them to hunt lots of animals (ex. fish)
- Made "lamps" (out of stone bowls with animal grease and fur inside)
- Made necklaces out of shells and animal teeth
- Made flutes/whistles from animal bones

### Farming:

- Discovered you could collect seeds and plant them for food
- Planted barley, rice, oat, sunflowers, and beans
- Helped people stay in one place
- Learned to tame animals (ex. goats, sheep, cattle, chickens, etc.)
- Used fire to cook food

### Paintings:

- Made paintings on walls
- Used many colours
- Paint made from rock-powder and animal fat
- Brushes made from animal hair tied to bone
- Most pictures about hunting
